July is civil aviation with; "Airplane," "The High and The Mighty," "Airport," and "The Concorde: Airport '79." August is military month with; "The Bridges of Toko Ri," "BAT-21," "Black Hawk Down," "Tuskegee Airmen," and "Top Gun."

Saturday's selections will be a variety of military movies from World War I to the present, with comedies to historical to sci fi.
